

## Dyskadores' dollops 2

Prepare labeled pots, either with the coloured food-stuffs previously used or with actual paints.

Ask a pupil, "Py liw yw da genes?"

Which colour do you like?

**Py liw yw da genes?"** If they reply "Da yw genev vy rudh!" allow them to dollop a good splodge of tomato ketchup (or red paint) onto a sheet of sugar paper.

Using a paint brush, make the red splodge into a 'sun' or a 'clown's nose' or 'a tomato'.

Announce, "Da yw genev vy rudh! I like red! Da yw genev vy rudh!"

Ask another pupil "Py liw yw da genes? Which colour do you like? **Py liw yw da genes?"** If they reply "Da yw genev vy glas!" allow them to dollop a good splodge of blue-coloured ice-cream (or blue paint) onto a sheet of sugar paper.

Use the paint-brush to make the blue splodge into 'the sea' or 'two eyes' or 'a policeman's helmet'.

Announce "Da yw genev vy rudh ha da yw genev vy glas! " I like red and I like blue! Da yw genev vy rudh ha da yw genev vy glas!"

Continue allowing pupils to add dollops to your 'picture' and build up your sentence. Once pupils have got the idea allow them to create pictures in groups.

Each time the paint-brush gets passed along, the next pupil must correctly point to and name all the colours used so far, for example, "Da yw genev vy rudh, ha da yw genev vy glas, ha da yw genev vy melyn!"

Once they have got that right then they are allowed to add their own 'dollop' to the picture.
