

Workshop Overview

In this activity, learners can be challenged to role play a weather forecast, using a map of Britain and Ireland. Using the cards from the pair matching activity, create a 'hat' of [PLACE] cards and a 'hat' of [NOUN/ ADJECTIVE] cards, also lay an array of [SYMBOL] cards nearby. The learner must draw a [PLACE] and [NOUN/ ADJECTIVE] card at random. Use the sentence structures below to give the weather forecast, then place/blue tac the [SYMBOL] in the correct location on the map. You could run this as a whole group activity with learners taking turns, or create multiple sets and run the activity in pairs.

Learners will need to use the long form of 'bos' with [NOUN] and the short form with [ADJECTIVE] cards.

Yma [NOUN] hedhyw yn [PLACE].









